






## Chief Adamson's Comments:

➤ **Operations & Training:** Services without reports (374) was mostly comprised of traffic stops (137), Building Security Checks (127), Investigative follow-up (40), and paper service (33). Much coordination was done in March for April's Rapid Response Training that will be conducted by multiple agencies in Horicon this April 9<sup>th</sup>. Officer Jason Roy is the lead coordinator for the Horicon Police.

➤ **Staffing & Overtime:** Applications continue to come in for the police lieutenant position. The announcement closes on April 24<sup>th</sup>. There was a total of 108.25 hours of overtime in March. 61 was Administrative Overtime (officers taking vacation, comp time, sick time, etc.) and 47.25 hours was Operational Overtime (court, late calls, transports, etc.). Part-time Officer Amy Yahnke has returned to Active Status with us. She currently works as a Deputy for Dodge County Sheriff's Office in court security and recreation patrol and is also a part-time police officer for Lowell.
