







Overtime Summary



Chief Adamson's Comments:

Operations & Training: Services w/o reports included 177 business / residential security checks, 35 follow-up investigative actions, 29 process / paper service instances, 12 EMS / Fire assists, and 9 attempts to serve warrants in the City. There were 31 times outside agencies assisted in the City. Adopt-A-Ward activity this month included 15 awareness contacts (mostly junk accumulation) and 1 citation (dog at large). With the warmer weather we can expect calls-for-service to increase. Horicon Heroin Summit is April 10th from 6:30-8:30 PM. Drug Drop & Bike Registration are taking place at the Horicon PSB April 26th.

Staffing & Overtime: Paid-not-Worked was relatively low this month with few officers taking earned benefit time. Administrative OT was 56.5 hours and Operational OT was 118.25 hours for a total of 174.75 hours. The greatest amount of Operational OT (88 hours) was a direct result of In Service. Another significant piece was due to follow-up investigations for crimes.
