






**Operations & Training:** Adopt-A-Ward saw 6 Awareness contacts for grass/weeds, 6 Awareness contacts for improper storage, 2 Awareness contacts for building code violations (no siding), 1 Awareness for a junk vehicle, and 1 Awareness for 48-hour parking. Calls w/o reports included 147 security checks, 39 follow-up investigative events, 28 paper service events, 19 ambulance assists, 15 animal complaints, 15 school events, and 10 ordinance violations. The School Partner Program saw several behavior incidents, a presentation on Drugs, several walk-and-talks during recess or lunch, and 2 officers that attended Graduation. LT Saunders attended an Instructor Update, Officer Johnson & K9 Dusty re-certified, and Officer Mantych attended a Heroin Overdose Investigation class. All officers completed semi-annual firearms qualification with primary service handgun, patrol rifle, and conducted energy weapon (CEW) aka Taser.

**Staffing & Overtime:** Officers and Administration staff continue to fill the gaps in scheduling to maintain minimum service levels. There were 235 hours of paid-not-worked, 40 hours of operational OT, and 134 hours of administrative OT (part-time covered 77 hrs and full-time covered 57 hours). The majority of operational OT was incurred during firearms qualification.
