






Chief Adamson's Comments:

Operations & Training: Calls w/o reports included building/security checks (158), traffic stops (81), follow-up investigative contacts (49), motorist assist (31), EMS calls (21), and traffic incidents (20). Horicon assisted the county with two serious crashes this month. Dodge County provided a Critical Incident Debrief that was attended by both police and EMS. Jersey Street Music Festival was uneventful from a police perspective and appeared well received by attendees. Ms. Mantai completed Law Enforcement Administrative Professional update. Officers attended 4 hours of legal update by the District Attorney's Office. There were 34 Adopt-A-Ward contacts this month addressing RV storage on streets, lawn maintenance, and accumulation of refuse in yards.

Staffing & Overtime: Jason Roy assumed his new role as Lieutenant at the end of June. There were 123 hours of admin OT and 31.75 hours of operational OT. Part time officers worked all but 12 hours of the admin OT saving nearly \$2,300 in OT costs this month. There were 112 hours paid-not-worked.
