



### Overtime Summary



**Operations & Training:** Adopt-A-Ward saw 4 Awareness for junk accumulation, 3 Awareness for brush piles, 2 Awareness for grass/weeds, 2 Awareness for improper storage, 2 Awareness for code violations (no siding), and 1 Warning for code violation (Marsh Automotive process served). Calls w/o reports included; 156 business/residential security checks, 35 follow-up investigative events, 25 paper/process services, 21 ambulance assists, 11 animal complaints, 10 warrant attempts, and 10 suspicious activity events. K9 Dusty and Handler Johnson did 1 small-group demo and performed 4 sniffs during traffic stops where he alerted one time (no contraband located). AA Mantai attended LE Administrative Professionals Training, Officer Johnson attended a rifle transition course, and Officer Perkins attended Field Training Officer Course. Our window services have dropped 50% with the relocation of the Court Clerk Office.

**Staffing & Overtime:** There were 360 hours paid-not-worked (179 Vacation, 20 Holiday, 160 Sick, and 1 Comp Time). There was 121 hours of Administrative OT (PT covered 36 hours and FT covered 85 hours), 78 hours of Operational OT, and 60 hours of unfilled shifts. PT Officer Todd Shultis was promoted to FT and started his Field Training on June 14<sup>th</sup>. He is filling shifts and training thru July and will fall into a normal rotation on August 1<sup>st</sup>.
