


Operations & Training: Calls w/o reports (and calls of note) included: 190 residential / business security checks, 20 EMS call assists, 16 Paper/Process services, 13 Follow-Up investigative actions, 12 Animal Complaints, 6 calls related to overdoses, 6 traffic crashes, and 4 calls related to self harm. Adopt-A-Ward saw 7 contacts for Improper Storage (x3), Operate UTV/ATV on City Streets (x2), and Junk Accumulation (x2). Our K9 Program saw 4 contacts with 2 resulting in Alerts that resulted in the illegal stun gun being seized along with drug paraphernalia from 2 vehicles. Our School Partner Program saw a Bike Rodeo at St. Stephens Child Care. Two officers attended Rapid Response Training in Mayville put on by the FBI.

Staffing & Overtime: There were 90 hours paid-not-worked. There was 110.5 hours of OT (72 Administrative / 38.5 Operational). Operational OT included 22 hrs OWI Grant, 8.5 hrs Training, 6 hrs Court, and 2 hrs Late Call. There were 38 patrol hours covered by a supervisor, cover officer, or went unfilled. Three new Part Time Officers were hired to fill vacancies. 2 of the three should complete training in August and be ready to fill shifts.
