






**Operations & Training:** Investigations this month included ongoing efforts on the suspected heroin overdose death from September, repeated 3<sup>rd</sup> Degree Sexual Assault of a Child, Endangering Safety By Use of A Dangerous Weapon, 6 drug arrests & 14 juvenile citations/referrals. Non-report calls included; 169 security checks, 41 paper services, 31 follow-up investigative events, 22 EMS assists, and 13 animal complaints. HPD hosted 11 Scouting boys at the Public Safety Building for a tour and presentation on safety and smart choices. Multiple officers and K9 Dusty presented smart choices and the pitfalls of drugs to HHS students during Red Ribbon week. K9 Dusty & Handler Johnson presented during lunch at the Senior Meal Site. Two HPD officers assisted Mayville PD during school evacuation drills. HPD also supported the homecoming parade, homecoming game, and Trick-or-Treating (with help from HFD & DCERT).

**Staffing & Overtime:** Peer interviews for the lieutenants position will occur on November 12<sup>th</sup> with PFC interviews occurring on December 3<sup>rd</sup>. Follow-up investigations on the multiple cases mentioned above resulted in about 44 hours of OT as part of the 87.75 hours of Operational OT. Paid-not-worked was 122 hours. Admin OT was 147 hrs with 77% of those hours filled by part-time officers.
