Horicon Police "Take Back" Unwanted Prescription Drugs October 17th

Horicon, WI – On October 17 from 11 a.m. to 2 p.m. the Horicon Police Department will give the public its tenth opportunity in 5 years to rid their homes of potentially dangerous, expired, unused, and unwanted prescription drugs. Bring your medications for disposal to the Horicon Public Safety Building at 220 Ellison Street. The service is free, anonymous, and no questions asked.

"The Take-Back Initiative helps Horicon residents properly dispose of prescription medications that are old, left over or found which reduces the potential for abuse, having them end up in our landfills, or having them go through our wastewater treatment plant" stated Horicon Police Chief Joseph Adamson. Adamson also said that the process for dropping off prescription medications is quicker and easier than the drive thru at a fast food restaurant.
